A MESSAGE TO OUR DONORS


As the person responsible for implementing the policy direction of CPL, I can tell you that every donor dollar makes a real difference in helping us achieve our objectives.

ABOUT CPL: OUR PROGRAMMING AND ENGAGEMENT – DONOR DOLLARS AT WORK

NATIONAL CONFERENCE

The CPL national conference is our premier event. Because of the pandemic, our annual conference was hosted online. A record 170 participants met, including **49 sponsored medical students and residents** taking advantage of networking and learning from speakers. This conference has a significant impact on the way attendees can defend their pro-life beliefs. The conference included Dr. Lauris Kaldjian speaking on Conscience in Medicine and Dr. Priscilla Coleman on the Impact of Abortion on Women’s Mental Health.

The day after the conference we received this email from a student:

“I really enjoyed the conference over the weekend. We are having some ethics lectures this morning, and duty to refer came up. I was able to ask the lecturer a question, inspired by a couple of the sessions!”

MENTORING PROGRAMS

Launched in 2018, the mentoring programs are open to both medical students and residents. In 2020, **31 students** took advantage of the mentoring program. We continue our collaboration with Dr. Majeres of Harvard Medical School and his team at Optimal Work to enhance our mentoring programs. We have integrated the Optimal Work platform into our mentoring program. We are also providing our mentors with additional training and access to Master Class training.

LEARNING PLATFORM

Launched in 2018, the Learning Platform hosts the conference programs and CPL resources. Resources are grouped into learning packages and include programs on Abortion, Euthanasia, Conscience and the Abortion Pill Reversal.

At the end of 2020, we have **608 users** totalling **2092 enrollments** on our Learning Platform, which represents a 50% increase in users from last year.

CRISIS LINE

The Crisis Line is available for medical students, residents, and physicians who find themselves pressured to violate their conscience. When someone contacts our crisis line, we do an initial assessment. Sometimes the issue can be resolved but if not, they are put in contact with a constitutional lawyer. The connection happens within 24 hours of initial contact with CPL.

ABORTION PILL REVERSAL NETWORK

We continue our partnership with the Abortion Pill Reversal Network. We encourage physician involvement with the network and are providing more resources on our Learning Platform to support this important initiative. We continue to work on expanding the network of physicians involved in this important initiative.

LEGAL AND POLITICAL OUTREACH

In 2020 we led the effort to build a network of like-minded organizations and individuals across professional disciplines to help us move the legislative needle on life issues. CPL is focused on building a conscience “big tent” with organizations and individuals from a variety of backgrounds. This ‘big tent’ approach will help to deliver legislative success.

In 2020 we partnered with the Society for Academic Freedom and Scholarship to intervene in the Rafael Zaki and University of Manitoba case. This case will go to court in 2021.

We also worked closely with physician groups and individual physicians to advocate for changes to Bill C-7, including the successful press conference with Michael Cooper, MP to pressure the Justice Committee to accept the written briefs of physicians who had been arbitrarily excluded from consideration by the Committee.





2020 Revenues




2020 Expenses

HIGHLIGHTS FROM OUR 2020 FINANCIAL STATEMENTS:

The majority of our donations are received from individual donors.



- There are four major sources of revenue for Canadian Physicians for Life. We receive funds from individual donations, foundations, conference sales and planned giving. The majority of our donations are received from individual donors.
- We spend over 80% of donations on programs to support medical students, residents, physicians, and other healthcare professionals.
- In 2020 our biggest expenditures were on the National Conference, the Mentoring Programs and our advocacy and outreach.

The total revenue and total expenses shown here for the year ended December 31, 2020 are based on the organizations' audited financial statements. 
